Social Security

A recent amendment to the Social Security Law provides that when a reduced payment is involved (under age 65), a widow's or widower's first month of entitlement to survivors payments can be no earlier than the month of filing an application for payments, except in specific limited circumstances.

except in specific limited circumstances.
In the past, payments could be made retroactively for as many as 12 months prior to the month of filing application.

under the new provision, when a widow widower does not apply in the month of the death of the deceased wage earner it may result in the loss of one or more months of payments. This may be especially true

if the death occurs in the latter part of a month.

Although the delay in filing application will result in a slightly higher monthly payment, the widow or widower may prefer the ad-

ditional monthly payments at a lower rate.

The Social Security Administration requests the assistance of funeral directors in advising widows or widowers to contact their Social Security office promptly to avoid a loss of payments.

Where circumstances prevent a widow or widower from visiting the Social Security office before the end of the month of the wage earner's death, he or she should be advised to write or telephone Social Security.

This action would protect the right of an eligible widow or widower to receive a payment for the month of the notification of intention to apply.

This change in the law has no affect on the payment of the Lump Sum Death Payment, only on monthly survivor's payments.
