Holder for Govenor

Democratic gubernatorial candidate Paul Holder has called on Governor Michael O'Callahan to convene a special session of the legislature to institute legislation making it legal to cultivate small amounts of marijuana as well as to decriminalize possession of specific amounts.

In a letter to the Governor, the Candidate said the possession of marijuana should not be a criminal problem. "The costs of making it such are just too great," said Holder, "The waste of time, money and other re-sources of the criminal justice system can no longer be justified.

'Much more significant," he added, "are the inestimable costs to both individuals and society of making criminals of decent human beings and the encouragement of the citizenry, particularly the young, to disrupt and to disturb our laws and those who make and enforce them.'

Pointing to President Carter's message to Congress last July, Holder said the President himself has correctly recognized trying to stamp out marijuana use would be as futile and as costly as prohibition's attempt to eliminate liquor consumption.

"The laws against marijuana in Nevada are a joke," said Holder, "unfortunately a cruel joke. Thousands of us have been arrested because of it, arrests which represent an enormous social cost which has accomplished nothing."
