Ingenious American scientists are making great strides in finding new ways to better our old way of life.

For one thing, we can send up satellites that make television specials visible worldwide, and telephone calls around the world easier, faster, and cheaper, too.



Scientists have developed energy-saving heat pumps that extract warmth from cold air and cool warm air, to keep homes comfortable year-round, without using up too much precious fossil fuel.



A textile company's scientists have pioneered the development of several pollution-control devices and processes. In fact, the J. P. Stevens Company has spent more than \$20 million for environmental controls over the past 12 years.

**Workers' Wants**

Most good business people have found it a big help, if they want to succeed, to have a good understanding of the needs of their employees, including their attitudes towards unions.

The National Labor Relations Act specifically states that employees have as much right to oppose a union as they have to join one, and many workers are doing just that. Throughout the country only a fifth of the labor force is unionized.

At J. P. Stevens, for instance, employees have rejected the union in 11 out of 12 elections held.

Several explanations have been given for the union's loss record. These include community opposition to union organization. There is opposition by the workers
