Hot Water A Must For Automatic Dishwashers

Automatic dishwashers have eliminated the need for one of the most time-consuming chores in the kitchen... washing the dishes after every meal. Yet even an automatic dishwasher requires some effort and some consideration to operate efficiently.

According to the experts at General Electric, water should be at 140 to 150° F as it enters the dishwasher. (On the Celsius scale, that's 60 to 66°C.) Water any cooler than 140° could reduce washability. Water any hotter than 150° is a waste of energy.

Water temperature can be checked at the faucet nearest the dishwasher by letting it run until it heats up and then measuring the temperature with a candy thermometer.

Try to plan activities so other heavy uses of hot water such as washing clothes or bathing don't occur at the same time you're washing dishes.

Other ways you can help dishwasher performance include:

• Proper loading. Load items so soiled surfaces will face the spray of water and so water will drain off for proper drying. Plates and saucers should face the center of the washer. Pots, pans and casseroles should be loaded in the lower racks with open end down. Silverware should be loaded handles up.

• Proper detergent. Use only dishwasher detergent. Other types are too high sudsing and too mild to work in dishwashers. Be sure your detergent is fresh and dry. Old detergent that is caked or lumpy may have lost its strength. Use the proper amount of detergent. Too much detergent in soft water

can result in a white, milky appearance on dishes that cover and unscrewing the cannot be removed. Too little plastic cap. • Wash arm. Check the moving arm (or arms if there are more than one) to be sure its movement is not blocked by dishes or anything sticking and replace the cap and above or below the racks. If your dishwasher is equipped with a center wash tower, be careful not to block its way when you have a full load. so it can extend fully during the wash and rinse cycles. will remove the soil.
