NEW FINDINGS are leading to better earthquake prediction and the probable saving of thousands of lives.

In Japan geologists have found that the ground tilts slightly a few days before an earthquake. A Soviet Union study indicated that a change in the pattern of microearth-quakes (detected only by sen-sitive instruments) precedes a quake. Another study suggests that controlled pumping of water into deep wells may be used to produce many small artificial tremors, releasing strain and possibly preventing major earthquakes.
