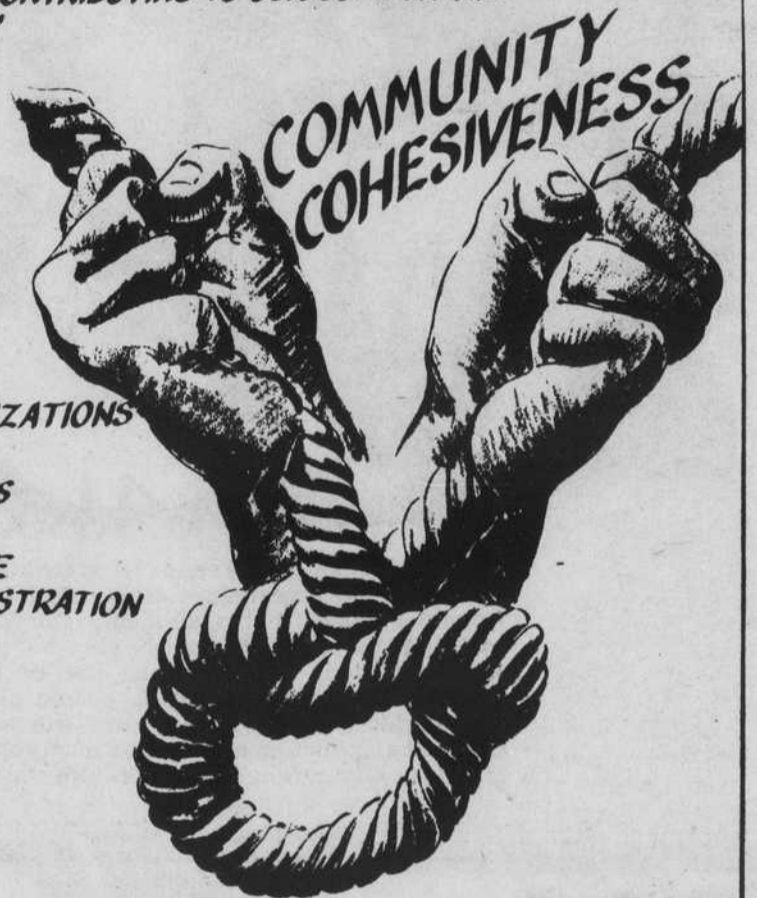

Cultivating Black Capitalism The Chrysler Concept

Rumors of Chrysler corporation's collapse is the same as Mark Twain once said of his own death, "greatly exaggerated." True the company is expecting a deficit in earnings for 1978's third quarter ending this month. But its up hill or rather Fifth Avenue New Yorker all the way for the world-wide automobile producer.

As the smallest, most leveraged or borrowed fund user and least integrated member of the "Big Three" automakers, Chrysler's earnings tend to fluctuate dramatically. Chrysler's operating results through the remainder of this decade will be dictated by its five year \$7.5 billion program in North America.

In modernizing inner city plants to produce its new entries in the big luxury prestige sector of the car market, minorities are asked to be partner in the reconstruction of the inner city.

Walter (Buzz) Luttrell, Chrysler Corporation's urban affairs executive ran off quickly to get information for me about Chrysler Corporation's Lynch Road Assembly plant located in the heart of Detroit's black districts.

Lynch Road Assembly plant has plus 80% blacks on its payroll. Chrysler is injecting \$57 million to modernize and convert the plant to produce new lines of totally-redesigned full-sized Chrysler New Yorker, Newport and Dodge St. Regis, including the all new limited addition Chrysler New Yorker Fifth Avenue.

A champagne car which out sparkles anything on the continent with its clean suave body. Blacks look good in this car, according to everyone of them that sat in its leather seats in Atlanta at Chrysler's National preview show. Blacks will be building this unique baby in the 50 year old plant which has new tools, machinery and equipment for the effort.

R. K. Brown, Executive Vice President North America Automotive, stated that Chrysler is not only Detroit's number one employer and tax payer, but is determined to stay in Detroit. The Lynch Road Assembly plant alone employs 5,200 workers with an annual payroll in excess
