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Nevada Voter's League

A spokesman for the Nevada Voter's League, which voted to endorse Sarann Knight for City Commissioner at a meeting held Sunday, said today that League members were surprised to hear partisan politics introduced into a non-partisan campaign.

Marjorie Elliot, League Chairman, referred to a statement issued by a member of the Executive Committee of the Clark County Republican Central Committee who opposes Knight's candidacy announced that though he was not speaking for the board, he and several others are "soliciting fellow Republican Woodrow Wilson to run."

Elliot said the Boters League is definitely a non-partisan one, committed to supporting representative candidates for office regardless of party affiliation. She also said that Woodrow Wilson, a long time friend of Sarann Knight, is permitting use of his "Wooky's Supper Club" at "H" and Owens as Sarann Knight's Campaign headquarters. The Voter's League Chairman further stated the Campaign Committee has begun meeting every Monday night at 8:00 p.m. and that at last Monday's meeting Woodrow Wilson was of the most effective supporters present in delineating strategy and tactics for the Sarann Knight's campaign.

Elliott also said it should be remembered that Sarann Knight had never considered the idea of running for political office although she has always been a political activist. Rather, she was actually recre

was actually recruited as a candidate by a citizen's committee, headed by Lubertha Johnson, who had been engaged for weeks in recruting a candidate meeting criteria established by the group. The Citizen's Committee had agreed that eo be eligible for consideration a candidate (a) should have lived and worked in the community (b) possess required ability and proven dedication (c) have been involved in the leading civil rights, economic, and social organizations representative of the highest aspirations of the community. Knight simply emerged the consensus candidate much to her supriese and no little consternation.

Dr. James McMillan, President of the Las Vegas NAACP, said of Knight's candidacy that this choice of the people is an ideal one. He noted that Mrs. Knight has been a successful businesswoman here for twenty (20) years and had operated a casino for seven of those years. He said Mrs. Knight and her family have formed a corporation and will soon break ground for the first units of an apartment complex.

McMillan also noted that Mrs. Knight has just been re-elected 1st Vice President of the NAACP and that she also serves as the organization's Membership Chairman. He said the unprecedented increase in membership rolls under her chairmanship is just another indication of the zeal and ability Knight brings to any undertaking.

Dr. McMillan stated he feels the Black Community is united behind Sarann Knight as its candidate for Citty Commissioner. He also said the community has no animosity against Roy Woofter, noting Woofter is a member of NAACP. "Blacks just want true representation," the NAACP Presdent said. He added that one thing for sure is that Sarann Knight's candidacy provides an answer to everyone in the City who is sick and tired of the machinations of "the good old boys."
