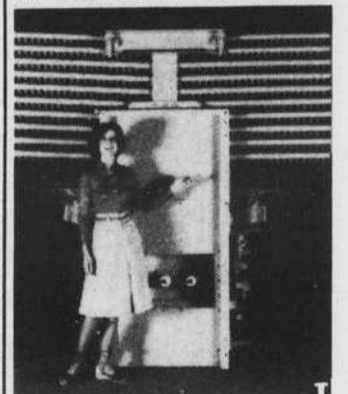

New Technology Fights Inflation, Protects Environment
