Good news for people of se Southwestern United Southwestern States: There is now a drug that can fight Valley Fever. An ill-wind bodes no good

when it carries the fungal infection called Valley Fever. This flu-like illness affects some 85,000 people a year.



In more than half the cases, those who inhale the spores of fungus are rendered im-mune. But in about 40 percent, symptoms develop ranging from mild respiratory infection to infections of the bones, joints, internal organs and lining of the brain. It's estimated there may be up to 50 deaths a year from Valley Fever.

However, a life-sustaining drug, developed by Ortho Pharmaceutical Corp., is now used to treat this fungal infection. It's called Monistat i.v.

Known medically as coccidioidomycosis (cocci for short, it also is found in simi-lar climate areas of Mexico and Central American countries, and in Paraguay, Colombia, Venezuela and Argentina.
