

## NCAA INFRACTIONS HEAD SEES NO NEED TO PUNISH TARKANIAN

It now appears that the NCAA, which placed the UNLV basketball program on probation two years ago, will take no further action against the university providing head coach Jerry Tarkanian is successful in a court case contesting his suspension by the university.

"Tark" was ordered dismissed from his coaching job as part of NCAA-imposed sanctions against the school basketball program two years ago. The Coach later sought and received a permanent injunction against his dismissal, an injunction which was overturned by the Nevada Supreme Court several months ago.
