They were there as I began to climb the ladder of success and on September 28th, they will be there to join me at the top of the rung as the heavyweight champion and everybody's number one contender. Leading up to the dramatic rematch between Holmes and Shavers will be a Superbantamweight Championship fight featuring Wilfredo Gomez against the number three contender Carlos Mendoza. Gomez made believers of the world of his ring prowess when he stopped the mighty Carlos Zarate. Holmes and Gomez shared the honor of being WBC fighters of the year in 1978.

The two hottest names in the welterweight class, Roberto Duran and Sugar Ray Leonard will take on hungry challengers hoping to make headlines by upsetting these two stars. Duran who was formidable as the lightweight champion gains more status in the heavier class with every fight. He comes to this card off a classic victory over Carlos Palomino.
