ferent kind of place and enjoyed her visit here in the "entertainment capital of the world."

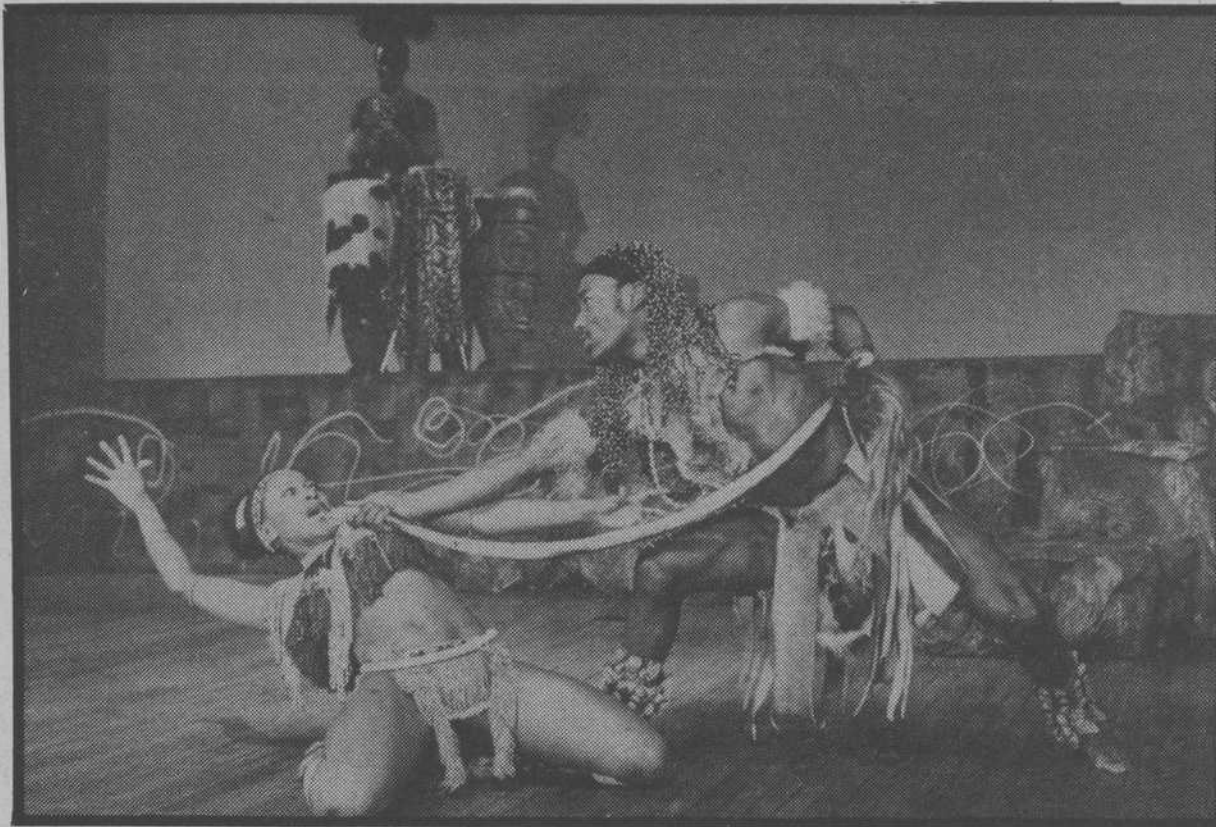
