What went Haywire?

We like to think that any disorder can be explained and repaired. For every failure, we hope to find a reason; for every problem, an invention, a medicine, a method, a corrective. The belief that this is possible serves us in many important ways—not the least of which is making sense of the world. And if we can find an explanation for why others had bad luck, we can avoid their mistakes-and thereby their misfortune.

Even those who meet up with disaster make an itemized list of what went wrong. Clearly, it is more comfortable to take blame on oneself (if one cannot find someone or something else to blame) than to imagine that the world is irrational and people's lives

don't make sense.

'Haywire,' airing Wednesday, May 14 on CBS-TV (airdate tentative), is based on the memoirs of Brooke Hayward, one of three children of movie star Margaret Sullavan and producer Leland Hayward. It is not only her story, but the story of her famous parents, her difficult and unbalanced siblings, and the glamorous families of the Hollywood and Broadway worlds of the 1940's.

What is distinctive about this family's story is that the disease (and unease) of the children was not the product of insane behavior of a mother like Joan Crawford or like Judy Garland's exploitation. The Hayward children were not abandoned or abused, as was Marilyn Monroe. According to daughter Brooke, Margaret Sullavan focused on her home, her husband, and her children. She invested her talents in their home—a place where everyday work and play were made exciting.

Both parents were consistent in their rigorous but reasonable demands and support of their children. They gave of themselves, of their time and patience Although they both worked and were successful, nothing indicates that they made sacrifices of their children, or indeed of their marital relationship, on the

altar of public success:

At home, the family engaged in charming and lively dinner conversation, played together, examined closely the beauty and basics of natural settings. When the children were sick, mommy Margaret would climb into bed with the ailing child and read to him or her until she was hoarse. The children were encouraged to share, to express themselves, to work hard. This fairy tale family should have lived happily ever after. But they did not—by a long shot.

One can more easily find an explanation for what

happened in 'Haywire' by studying Job in the Bible and then studying the pages of psychoanalytic literature. But you be the judge. Perhaps I missed the essential piece of the puzzle. 
