The \$12 million Muhammad Ali-Larry Holmes showdown for the World Boxing Council Heavyweight Championship originally set for July 11 in Rio de Janeiro has dissolved due to a breakdown in the negotiations.

Prime Sports, the promoter of the fight, had difficulty in completing the necessary financial arrangements and other complications, including legal entanglements. There was also some feeling that it was impractical to hold the fight in Rio's 165,000-seat Maracana Stadium.

Ali was to receive \$8 million and Holmes would receive \$4 million in the fight to be co-promoted by Prime Sports' Murad Muhammad, a former security guard for Ali, and Don King Promotions. Each fighter was given an advance payment and the remainder of the money was to have been deposited in U.S. bank. It never made it.

MAGAZINE recalled: "Will we ever forget Joe's many homilies and quotes? Recall his answers to questions to Billy Conn's ability to survive against him. ("He can run but he can't hide.") And the most famous remark of all. when he quietly and surely predicted our victory in World War II because we were on God's side."

Arthur Daley. deceased, formerly of the New York Times: "One of the greastest and most enduring lines in sports journalism was contributed many years ago by Jimmy Cannon when he breathed life into the written word with an eloquent and emotional description of Joe Louis. It was: "He's credit to his race - the human race."

Singer Frank Sinatra: "Joe Louis fought everybody and if they gave him a good bout, he fought 'em again. He fought for his country and he tought often. He stood for America. Young Marvis Frazier, the son of Joe Frazier, former World Heavyweight Champion, helped to make the National Seniors AAU boxing championship, a super one with a spectacular win over Chris Mc-Donald of Tiverton, R.I. in the final fight at Caesars Palace last Saturday.

Frazier looked like his father in dominating his fight winning the national heavyweight championship. He executed well and followed his plan. "I felt that everything I was taught and everything I was trained to do, I did it," said Frazier. He was in control all the way hurting McDonald in the head with right and left hooks.
