

## Kennedy Seeks 'Alternatives'

NEWARK, N.J. - (NBNS) - "This may be our last clear chance to lead the nation out of the economic wilderness and to reclaim our economic heritage," Senator Edward M. Kennedy warned last week as he called for a massive public and private "Marshall Plan" to re-industrialize the country.

The Massachusetts Democrat, campaigning here for votes in the June 3 New Jersey primary, proposed setting up an "American re-industrialization corporation" that would use both Government and private capital to stimulate broadscale new investment in United States business and technology.

Kennedy has made the economy the centerpiece of his campaign to win the Democratic nomination. The policies of the Nixon, Ford and Carter administrations had caused "unprecedented" economic disaster, Senator Kennedy charged.

"This year, the Democratic Party must

not ratify and re-elect Republican economics and a Democratic label."

The Senator, without referring to the weekend of violence in Miami directly, said the Carter Administration's cuts in social programs proves it is not committed to making cities "livable."

In proposing a re-industrialization corporation to re-invigorate the U.S. economy, Kennedy said that the scope of the program should at least be as large as the Marshall Plan, which funneled American rehabilitation aid to Europe after World War II.

## Richard Pryor Is In Critical Condition

Comedian Richard Pryor, also known as a great screenwriter, director, producer and television star, was critically burned Monday night when a cigarette lighter exploded in his hand.

Pryor sustained a serious 50 percent total body surface burn over his hands, chest and face. He was treated by Dr. Jack Grossman at Sherman Oaks Community Hospital's burn center shortly after 8 p.m. "He's in critical but

stable condition at this time," said Dr. Grossman.

Grossman said a cigarette lighter exploded in Pryor's hand. Few details were available at the time of this report.

Fire Department paramedics reportedly picked up Pryor sprawled on Parthenia Street in the Northridge area of the San Fernando Valley, near Los Angeles.

Pryor, engulfed in flames, apparently ran into the street and collapsed.

## Los Angeles Told To Expand Busing

LOS ANGELES, CAL. — (NBNS) — A comprehensive busing program was ordered last week for the Los Angeles Unified School District, the nation's second largest, by Superior Court Judge Paul Egly, to effectively desegregate that system this fall.

The ruling was in response to a complaint filed 17 years ago by the American Civil Liberties Union, alleging that Los Angeles had developed a de facto pattern of segregated schools — a pattern, the A.C.L.U. said, that existed in fact, even if not in law — thus denying Black children an education equivalent to that of whites.

Under the terms of Judge Egly's decision, the school district, following guidelines in his order, must implement a system that integrates grades one through nine

begin phasing in an integration program for grades 10 through 12 in 1981.

The racial composition of the city has changed drastically during the intervening years since the original suit, with whites becoming a minority and Hispanic residents beoming the city's largest ethnic group.

The busing program now operating to desegregate Los Angeles schools was concluded by Judge Egly to have "carried the seeds of failure." Under Judge Egly's order, the district would be divided into 11 zones. Administrators would have to develop a system for integrating schools in each zone according to standards defined by the judge. Twenty minutes should be the maximum one-way commuting time for children, his order indicated.
