

Housing Hits New Low

Building starts on single-family homes in unincorporated Clark County has taken a dramtic nose-dive hitting record lows in May, plummeting 91 percent below what they were a year ago for the same month, according to statistics released by the housing industry.

In 1979, there were 359 building permits issued in Equal Justice the month of May. Only 35 were issued last month. halt. May is traditionally struction months.

Overall, it was reported, building is down 55 percent in 1980 so far from last year's activity with single-family home building maintaining only


