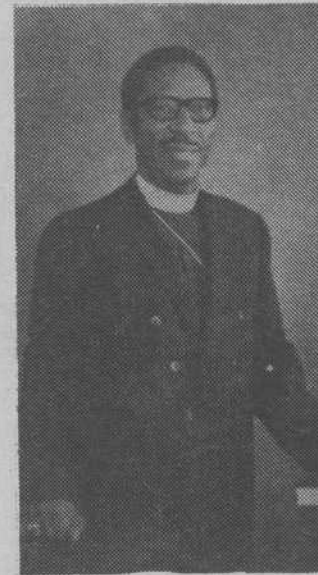
Almost two million customers of Common Wealth Edison Company in the Chicago area, it is reported, will soon be getting their utility bills made out by an electronic brain.
