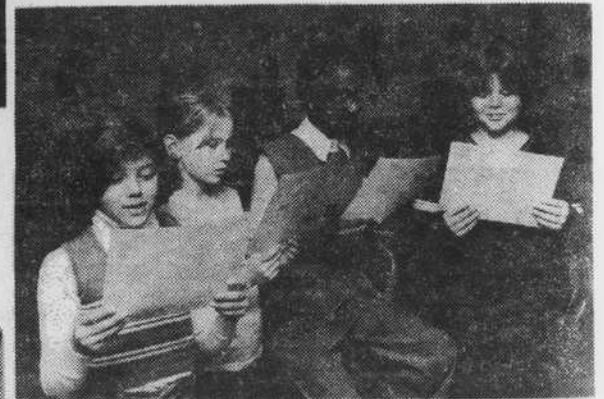


**SCHOOL DISTRICT SECURITY TRAINED**
