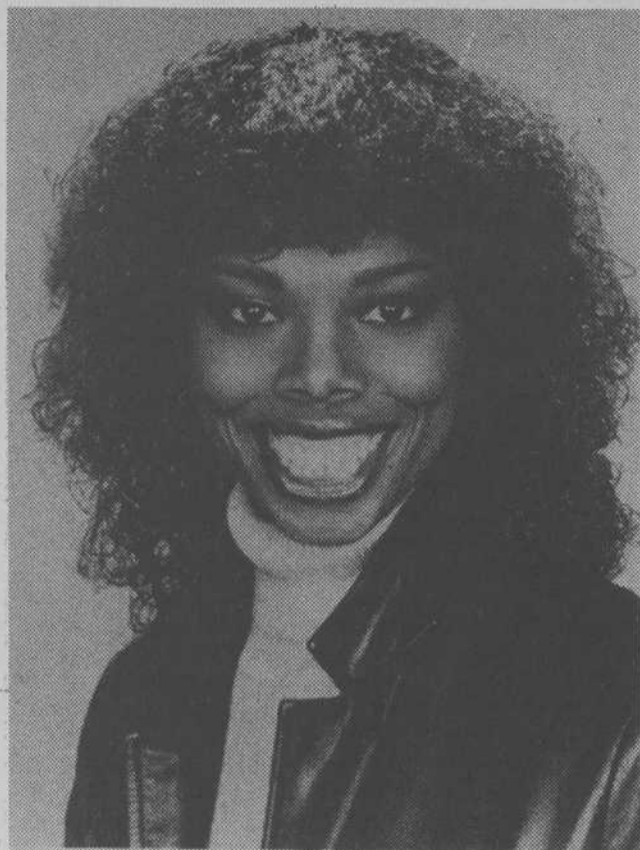

Millie Jackson: Live and Uncensored!

FOR MEN ONLY is the eagerly-awaited studio follow-up to the highly-praised LIVE AND UNCENSORED, and, with its release, Millie Jackson seems about ready to lay claim to her title as First Lady of Soul. Once again

co-produced with her long-time collaborator Brad Shapiro, FOR MEN ONLY tackles the social issues as only the great Millie knows how — with a no holds barred frankness and a sense of humor that spills off the record and

into your heart. This new LP should add to the legions of Millie Jackson fans who already recognize this superlative performer's multiple talents and abilities.

If LIVE AND UNCENSORED seared with explicit intensity, FOR MEN ONLY smolders with the type of unabashed honesty the public has come to expect from the very special and courageous Millie Jackson.

Georgia-born MILLIE JACKSON is no stranger to controversy, ever since her first single release for Spring Records, "A Child Of God," which dealt head-on with sexual and social hypocrisy. "A Child Of God" appeared on Millie Jackson's debut, self-titled album. Based on her work on that LP, Millie was named Most Promising Female Vocalist of 1972 by the National Association of

Television and Radio Artists (NATRA). In 1973, her single, "It Hurts So Good," was featured in the motion picture CLEOPATRA JONES. The hit album, IT HURTS SO GOOD, followed and won Millie the kukos of CASH-BOX MAGAZINE, which named her Best Female R & B Vocalist along with Aretha Franklin.

Millie's next two albums, MILLIE, and, especially CAUGHT UP, showed her to be not only a great vocalist, but an artist capable of picking and writing material perfectly in tune with the philosophical and emotional trends of our time. CAUGHT UP launched Millie into major stardom with its conceptual themes exploring the emotions of a love triangle. On one side of the album, Millie takes the character of a wife whose husband is involved with another woman while, on the flip side, she assumes the role of the mistress with total believability and compassion. Jackson sings a lot of strength into both women, even though she realizes that they are each at the mercy of the man they love.

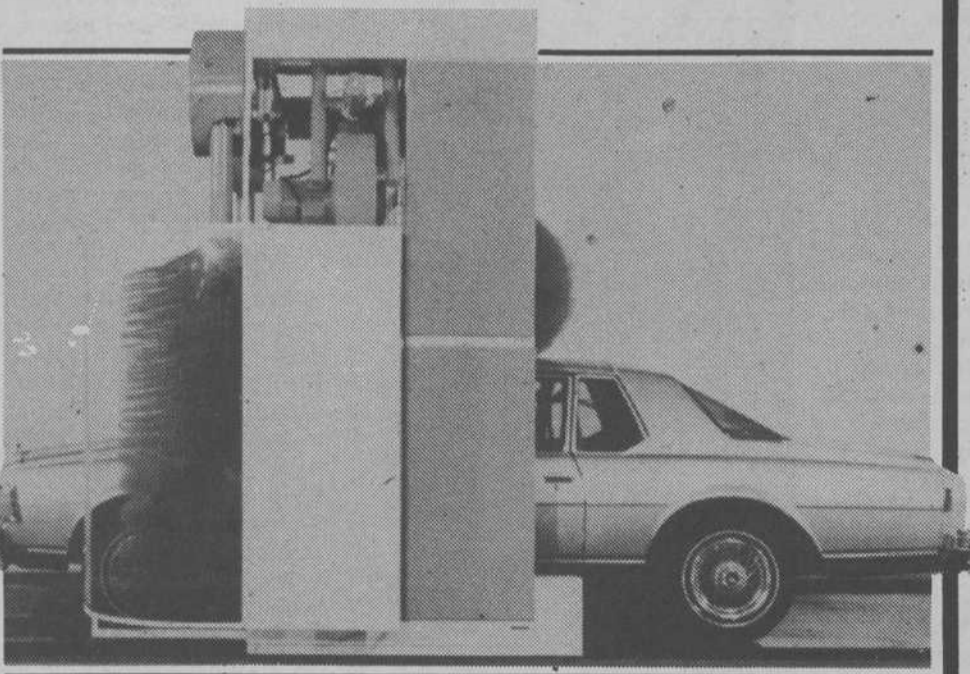
All workshops will take place at the Bethany Baptist Development Center, 1229 West Owens Avenue.
