

# ROCKEFELLER FOUNDATION AWARDS MINORITY GROUP

The Rockefeller Foundation today announced the winners in its Research Fellowship Program for Minority-Group Scholars.

Fifteen men and women were selected by a distinguished advisory panel from a group of approximately 150 applicants.

In the area of the social sciences, award winners will undertake research on problems of high priority affecting minority group members, in fields such as education, employment, housing and civil rights. Subjects to be studied include a policy analysis of the effects of Federal legislation upon the education of handicapped black children and an

analysis of the social interactional strengths of Mexican-American families.

In the area of the humanities, scholars will investigate subjects in disciplines such as history, literature, and philosophy, seeking to provide a humanistic perspective on minority-group issues. Award winners will study such wide-ranging subjects as the development of the barrio in Los Angeles, San Antonio, and Chicago; the rhetoric of the black American sermon; and the history of two Chinese American families from the Old World to the New, 1880-1980.

The advisory panel for the social sciences

awards consisted of Dr. Charles Hamilton, Professor of Political Science, Columbia University; Dr. Jose Fernandez, Professor of Sociology, University of Wisconsin; Dr. Barbara Jones, Professor of Business and Economics, Clark College; and Dr. Neal Sullivan, Professor of Educational Administration, California State University at Long Beach.

The Advisory panel for the humanities awards consisted of Dr. John Blassingame, Professor of History, Yale University; Dr. Addison Gayle, Professor of English, Baruch College of the City University of New York; Dr. Herbert Gutman, Professor of History,
