Nationwide Draft Signups Set To Begin Next Monday

The nationwide signup for peacetime draft is set to start next Monday. An estimated 6,500 young Clark County men will be ordered to troop to the local post office and register. An estimated 98 percent of the eligible 18-19- and 20-year-olds will participate.

The penalty for ignoring draft registration, as specified in legislation passed two weeks ago by Congress, is either a \$10,000 fine or imprisonment for up to 5 years, or both.

Registration for all men born in 1960 will start at

8:30 a.m. next Monday a call for registration. It is not a return to the draft.

Vegas postal service No draft cards will be issued, but each person area postal stations, who registers will receive a letter of Men, born in 1961 will register the week of July acknowledgement in 28-Aug. 1. November or December.

Men born anytime in 1962 will register by a 1961, regardless of similar process in physical handicaps, are January 1981. Thereafter, required to complete all teenage males will register when they turn 18.

Green and white registration cards with instructions printed on the reverse side will be left on tables in post office lobbies.
