Among the many attending were: Lee Walker,

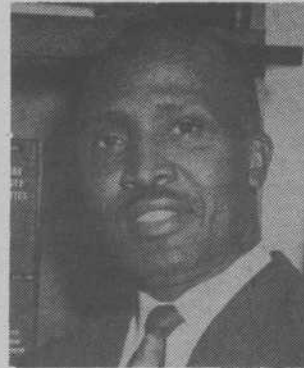
Jim Williams and others.
