'Fiddler On The Roof' At Meadows Playhouse

"Fiddler On The Roof," one of the most acclaimed musicals of all time, opened at The Meadows Playhouse July 15 for an extended run through August 16.

Based on stories by Sholom Alechem, the epoch making attraction is the story of Tevye (Art Engler) a desparately poor diaryman who lives in a Russian village with his sharptongued wife, Golde (Rene Martins) and his five daughters, three of whom are of marriageable age.

According to tradition, parents are to provide doweries for their daughters and a professional matchmaker, Yenta (Arlene Peikoff) provides them with husbands. The upheaval when this tradition is broken and the final crisis when the villagers must leave their homes are interwoven with the

memorable music, songs like "If I Were A Rich Man," "Sunrise, Sunset" and "Matchmaker, Matchmaker."

The cast of 25 is the largest to ever assemble on the Playhouse stage. Rehearsals began in mid-June in the recreation hall of the University United Church on Maryland Parkway and moved into the theatre after the play "Blithe Spirit" closed.

The production is sponsored in part by the American Nevada Corporation. Developers of Green Valley and is directed by Philip McKinley with Judy Brenner as musical director.
