Three men, last Thursday, were indicted for their alleged role in the murder of David Lee Kinnamon - the man who came home from work one night last month to find several men trying to rape

Indictments charging murder, burglary and robbery were returned against Thomas Nevius, 24; Vernon Art Tiger, 18; and Gregory Leon Everett, 19. Tiger and Nevius also were indicted for attempted sexual assault.
