Fire Education

Each year, over 300,000 people suffer fire-related injuries and more than 8,000 die.

During the calandar year 1979, there were no reported fire-related injuries or deaths in Neighborhood Strategy Areas I or II. However, there were several hundred thousand dollars in property damage reported. In NSA I, there was a total of 29 building fires and 21 false alarms reported. NSA II also had 29 building fires reported with 8 false alar-

Bearing these statistics in mind, the Las Vegas Fire Department's Education Division through Fire Safety Education and Home Inspections will work to reduce these statistics on the local level. The Education Division will be working out of Fire Station number 7, 1201 Miller.
