UNDEFEATED GOMEZ MEETS UNBEATEN HOLMES FRIDAY

Wilfredo "Bazooka" Gomez, the undefeated 23-year old World Super Bantamweight Champion, from Puerto Rico, makes the 12th defense of his WBC crown when he takes on unbeaten Derrick Holmes, the 24-year old pride of New Carrollton, Md., who knocked him out in the amateurs, over 15-rounds, or less, at Caesars Palace on Friday, August 22.

The Don King Production will be nationally telecast by the NBC Television Network as the third presentation of their "Friday Night Fights" series. There will be a blackout in Southern Nevada. The doors will open at the Caesars Palace Sports Pavilion at 5:00 p.m. with the first bout to start at 5:30 p.m.

The handsome Gomez, who set a new defense record when he scored his 11th consecutive knockout over Ruben Valdez of Colombia on February 3 at Caesars Palace, has set his sights

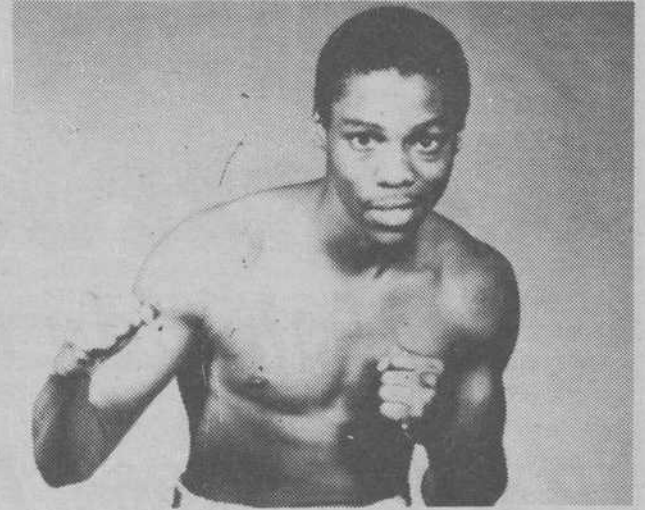
on the world feather-weight championship and this could possibly be the last defense of his 122-pound title. He began his career with a draw on November 16, 1974, and has since scored 29 successive knockouts. He won the Super Bantamweight crown on May 21, 1977 with a 12-round knockout of Don Kyun-Yum. The record stands at 29-0-1 with 29 knockouts.

Holmes, who will be 25 on August 23, is rated No. 8. He studied pre-law at the University of Maryland, and attended Computer School at the Goddard Space Flight Center before seriously taking up professional boxing.

One of the top amateurs in the world, Holmes compiled a 129-10 record with 75 knockouts, including the first-round knockout of Gomez in a nationally televised match for the North American Championship in 1974. Derrick is the first ever to win the

North American Championship three times — 1973, 1974 and 1975. He also won the Gold Metal in the Pre-Olympic International Championships in November of 1975 in Montreal. He turned pro in 1978 and has a record of 14-0-1 with 10 knockouts.

The action-packed card also features three 10-round bouts and a pair of four-round attractions. California Heavyweight

Champion Stan Ward of Sacramento, 12-3-2, battles Toni Pulu, the Utah Champion from Salt Lake City, 25-6-1.

Another 10-round match pits No. 2 rated WBA junior welterweight contender Lennox Blackmore of Guyana, 23-1 (12 KO's), against Ron Cummings, of Sacramento, 11-1-3 (4 KO's).

The third 10 has former NABF Champion Javier

Flores, 29-6-3 (20 KO's) of Salt Lake City against Puerto Rico's undefeated young sensation Edwin Rosario, 13-0 (13 KO's), in a Super Bantamweight showdown.

The four-round bouts, to be announced shortly, will feature the exciting talents of two undefeated youngsters last seen here on August 8 — Un-defeated middleweight Mark Holmes (2-0 1 KO),

the younger brother of World Heavyweight Champion Larry Holmes and the exciting 18-year old, Lonnie Smith from Denver who scored a dramatic knockout in his pro debut as a light-weight.

Tickets for the World Championship show, priced from \$50 down to \$10 are on sale at Caesars Palace in the Fantasy Tower Ticket Office.
