KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION

Children entering kindergarten for the coming school year, and first graders who have not previously attended school in Clark County, will be required to present birth certificates or other proof of date of birth.

Birth certificates for children born in Clark County from 1955 to the present can be secured at the Clark County Health Department, 625 Shadow Lane, Las Vegas. The fee is \$2.00.

Birth certificates for children born in Clark County before 1955, and those born in all other Nevada counties, can be secured at the Department of Health and Welfare, Division of Health, Section of Vital Statistics, 505 King Street, Room 102, Carson City. Nevada 89701. The fee is \$2.00.

Children must be five and six years old by September 30, 1980, to enter kindergarten and first grade, respectively.

Man Killed **Over Pool Game Tiff**


A man shot last Friday in a fight over a pool game died early Saturday from the wound, police said.
