## KNPR Sets Jazz Festival

National Public Radio will present a special Labor Day weekend event when "Jazz Alive!" transports listening audiences to the 1980 Chicago Jazz Festival.

Live via satellite from Chicago's Grant Park, the final three evenings of the festival will be broadcast at 9 p.m. Aug. 29-31 on National Public Radio's local member station, KN-

PR-FM (89.5). Each program will be four hours long.

The festivities will begin with an open invitation to "Charlie Parker's 60th birthday party," a celebrity of the memory and music of alto saxophonist Charlie "Yardbird" Parker, often acclaimed as the creator of modern jazz.

The tribute to Parker

will be marked by a lineup of jazz talents. Featured artists will be trumpeter Dizzy Gillespie, drummer Max Roach and pianist Jay McShann, who will sing and play his good-humored blues.

The festival is sponsored by the city of Chicago and coordinated by the Jazz Institute Of Chicago.

## KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION

Children must be five and six years old by September 30, 1980, to enter kindergarten and first grade, respectively.
