



'Kid Dynamite' Soundly Defeats 'Preacherman'

Hard-hitting Jorge "Kid Dynamite" Morales soundly defeated Frankie "Preacherman" Moultrie for the vacant North American Boxing Federation lightweight championship last Tuesday at the Showboat Hotel's new sports pavilion.

The fight highlighted the opening of the pavilion with the Showboat Fight Night program promoted by Las Vegas Tony Trudnich.

Kid Dynamite dominated the fight from the beginning, but

Moultrie managed to survive through the first five rounds. He was in trouble in the sixth and when knocked down near the end of the round, his chief second Stan Tischler jumped into the ring. At this point, mass confusion prevailed when Dynamite's corner complained that Tischler was in ring. Referee Ferd Hernandez allowed the fight to continue.

Morales came out "banging punches" to Moultrie's body and head in the sixth round with nearly all landing. He

pounded Preacherman to the canvas. The referee counted him out at 1:22 of the round.

It was Kid Dynamite's 29th win against six losses and two draws and his 23rd knockout. Moultrie dropped to 16-3. In the semi-main event, featherweight Ruben Castillo, 27-2, KO'd Roberto Garcia, 19-4-1, at 2:06 of the sixth round.

Nicky Perez, now 42-2, won a one-sided unanimous decision over an outclassed Jose Resendiz.
