Caesars Shows Mt. St. Helens Eruption

The fury and awesome power of Mother Nature has been on gala display for the past four months in the mountains of eastern Washington through the earth trembling antics of the volcanic Mt. St. Helens.

Caesars Palace is presenting a breathtaking chronicle of the events which have taken place since May 18, the first Mt. St. Helens explosion in the "Eruption Of Mt. Saint Helens," an Omnimax Newsreel by Graphic Films Corporation in Hollywood, CA.

Filmed in the usual Om-

nimax format, the film graphically tells a story of horrible devastation of what was once mountains and valleys of deep abundant green foliage with animal life.

The movie was filmed under the direction of George Casey, the Vice-President of Graphic Films. Through the eyes of his crew's cameras, Casey takes you on a bizarre journey through the devastated areas, and finally, along the rim and into the angry volcano itself.

The filming was accomplished on four

separate occasions, taken aboard helicopters surveying the wide swath of destruction created by the tumultuous volcano.

Also shown are incredible scenes of the surrounding area, with the residents of the state struggling to deal with the natural disaster in their own way. From the city of Yakama, Washington with its ashen-clogged streets, to the dangerous conditions of Highway 5, to the various rescue and emergency crews attempting to locate any survivors, "The Eruption of Mt. Saint Helens"

brings the viewer personally to the scene, with an uncanny realism that chills the senses.
