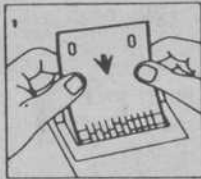
SPECIAL VOTER INSTRUCTION:
Following the names of the candidates for offices to be voted on statewide, appears an additional line labeled "none of these candidates". You may choose the "none of these candidates" line to express a lack of confidence in all the candidates, but only if you have not voted for any candidate listed under that office heading.

WARNING
No person who is entitled to vote shall vote or attempt to vote more than once at the same election. Any person who votes or attempts to vote twice at the same election is guilty of a gross misdemeanor.

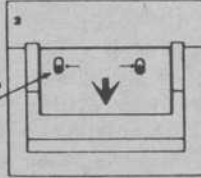

Instructions for voting at the polls

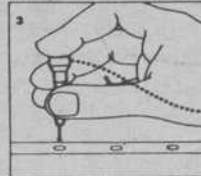
Step 1 Using both hands, insert the ballot card all the way into the Vote Recorder.



Step 2 Be sure the two slots in the end of your card fit down over the two red pins.



Step 3 To vote, hold the voting instrument straight up. Punch straight down through the ballot card for the candidates of your choice. Do not use pen or pencil.



Step 4 After Voting remove ballot card from the Votomatic and insert in inner pocket of grey envelope provided. Return ballot to precinct official. **DO NOT REMOVE STUB.**

You are entitled to vote all offices. **DO NOT** vote for more candidates than the instruction under the office allows.

NOTE: If you make a mistake you may return your ballot card and obtain another.

Otis Harris Leaving SNEDC Post For New Job

Otis Harris executive director of the Southern Nev. Economic Development Council reportedly will be leaving the post to develop business in the Southwest for several European and Mideast companies.

Harris reportedly will direct development of businesses somewhere in the Southwest from their inception, including purchase of properties. He will assume the new duties as soon as a

replacement can be located.

SNEDC, created by Harris four years ago, is a non-profit economic development company organized to promote economic development in the black community.

He started the agency after being released by the Las Vegas Convention and Visitors Authority. He brought a civil rights suit against the authority. It is reported that the suit was eventually settled out of court for \$10,000.

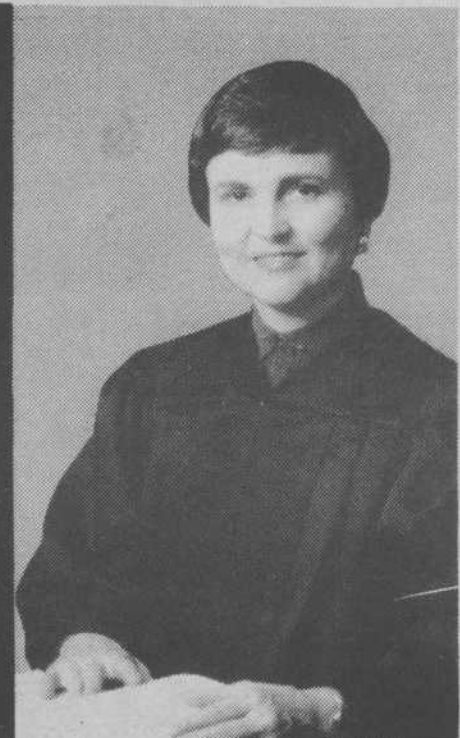
