

McCurdy Faces Neal, Wilson Opposes Bowler

Incumbent Joe Neal made a runaway of his race against Rev. A. J. Thompson in the Democratic primary for the Senate District 4 seat. The two-term senator had polled 1,772 votes, or 78.8 percent, compared with 477 for the long-time pastor of Victory Baptist Church.

The turnout was exceedingly low since the district has almost 5,400 registered Democrats.

On the Republican side, Bill McCurdy disengaged Janet C.

Baliotis from the campaign garnering 67 votes, or 62 percent, compared with 41 votes or 38.0 percent for Baliotis.

"I always try to represent the needs of my district," said Neal. "The vote shows people think I have done a pretty fair job."

McCurdy had charged during the campaign that Neal failed to bring economic benefits to the black community during his two terms. "I am very grateful for the overall support given me by the many registered

voters in our district," declared McCurdy. "I am now ready to face Neal in November."

Rev. Marion Bennett narrowly nipped Gene Collins in his quest for a sixth term in the Democratic primary for the Assembly District 6 post. Bennett carried 47.1 percent of the vote, or 474 votes. Collins received 42.0 percent of the votes cast, or 423 votes while candidate Larry J. Abdullah picked up 109 votes, or 10.8 percent. Bennett will face the Republican victor and Libertarian John

Ketchum.

In the District 7 race, three-time incumbent Lonie Chaney won over strong contender Louise H. Jordan picking up 781 votes, or 54.3 percent of the vote while Jordan received 39.5 percent of the vote, or 568 votes. Ozia Thomas and Dorothy M. Walker both picked up 44 votes, or 3.1 percent of the vote.

Sam Bowler, seeking his second term on the County Commission from District D got 2,710 votes, or 62.9 percent of the vote overtaking John B. Regan who got 1,597

votes, or 37.1 percent of the vote. Bowler will now face Republican candidate Woodrow Wilson in November.

In the District C Clark County Commission race Jim McMillan polled 1,250 votes, or 20.7 percent of the vote against Tom Miller's 4,112 votes, or 68.2 percent of the vote.

Richard A. Stephens, candidate in the Democratic District 18 race received 122 votes against incumbent Tom Hickey who ran away with 556 votes.

In the Justice of Peace

race, incumbent Earle W. White copped 11,780 votes, or 28.3 percent of the votes while John Sleeper won 13,598 votes, or 32.7 percent of the vote. The two top vote getters will face each other in the November general election. White was appointed to the bench last summer after Al Becker resigned in the midst of a bribe scandal.
