# UNLV Lists New Ticket Plan

Ticket prices and season have been announced by acting ticket manager Le Riggle. According to Riggle, reserved seat tickets for

the upcoming grid season prices will be \$8, \$7 and \$6 for adults, and at \$7, \$6 and \$5 for children under 17 years old. There will be a two dollar increase in the price of reserved tickets for the Brigham Young University game Nov. 29.

The UNLV Athletic Ticket Office will sell tickets from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday only.

On the day of a game, tickets will be sold only at the Las Vegas Silver Bowl westside ticket office which will be open from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Ticket windows on the west, south and east sides will re-open at 6 p.m. and will sell tickets through the third quarter of action.

Tickets for general admission seats, which are located in the upper end zones and the bleachers on the top of both sides, have been priced at \$3 for adults and \$1.50 for children under 17.

Tickets will be sold on a game by game basis at 12 outlets in the Las Vegas area.

In the city, tickets will be available at the Charleston Heights Bowl, Davey's Locker, Gordon's Donut Shop and the Hallmark Card Shops in the Boulevard Mall, the Meadows Mall and the Card Cupboard.

In the North Las Vegas area they can be found at the Keg Room, the Stadium Saloon in East

## Can Wells Triumph Over Evel Knievel?

Daredevil Gary Wells will attempt to jump his motorcycle nearly 200 feet over the spectacular fountains in front of Caesars Palace, Las Vegas, on September 15. This dangerous stunt was attempted unsuccessfully in 1967 by the legendary Evel Knievel; Wells' effort will be televised from the location on the fall premiere of the top-rated ABC-TV series, "That's Incredible!"

Gary Wells, who idolized the now-retired Knievel, was present for the latter's ill-fated attempt to soar over the hotel's fountains years ago. Commented the event's producer, George Englund, "It's only fitting that Gary Wells, now at the pinnacle of his career, returns to Caesars Palace for a televised attempt at the fountains. Caesars Palace is not only the home of many great sporting events, but is actually the third largest site of film and television entertainment from Los Angeles and New York."

In order to successfully complete the jump, Wells will have to surpass his own World-distance record of 176', 4 1/2", in addition to facing the increased hazard of the Caesars Palace people movers, which have been integrated into the fountain's superstructure

since Knievel's attempt. The structural changes at Caesars will force Wells to commit without the option of pulling out of the jump once he begins the final approach. Similarly, the area available for landing once the jump has been completed has been reduced considerably since it was last attempted in 1967.

Currently in training for the September 15 jump, Wells includes in his program hours of desert riding, running, and an extensive weight lifting regimen. His engineers have already been to Caesars Palace to begin building the specially-designed ramps for the jump. "Although Gary has a penchant for testing himself against unknown odds," explained "That's Incredible!" producer Woody Fraser, "his strong desire to succeed mandates careful planning and preparation. He does everything except actually practice the stunt, and that's why it's so dangerous."

Caesars Palace has also established itself as a major venue for sporting events. Next on the agenda at the hotel is Muhammad Ali's long-awaited return to the ring in a 15-round title bout with WBC Heavyweight Champion Larry Holmes, October 2.
