Congressional politics and by executive penny-Some pinching. programs promising were underfunded to the point where they could not make an impact. Others were broadened to the point where they

became so diffuse that they failed to help the neediest.

For political purposes, definitions of target populations are often broadened to include more people and more congressional districts, so funds are diverted from truly needy areas to better-off ones.

Federal programs leave much to be desired, but they shouldn't be replaced by panaceas and slogans that appear to offer even fewer prospective gains to blacks. Just dumping on government isn't enough; we have to ensure that government programs work the way

we want them to work.
