not considered blacks threatening, they had been permitted the right to vote for some years. By 1943, because of BMI, Henderson had become the third largest town in Nevada and there were over 11,000 registered voters there, while only 7000 were registered in Las Vegas. Between the

two places, there were approximately 3000 black registered voters.

The local chapter of the NAACP was revitalized. Blacks became more politically active and in greater numbers than ever before. They would soon be joined by other blacks who came with the military bases of World War II.

**OPERATION LIFE ANNOUNCES
NEW SATELLITE FOOD PROGRAM**

Operation Life announced today the opening of a satellite office for the Women, Infants and Children Supplemental Food Program (WIC). The new site is located at the NALA (National Association For Latin Americans) office at 323 North Maryland Parkway. Services will be available each Monday and Tuesday from 9:00 to

11:30 p.m. WIC provides highly nutritious foods — milk, cheese, eggs, juice, cereal, and baby formula to eligible pregnant and nursing women, infants and children to age 5. Local as well as national statistics show that WIC foods, given during critical periods of growth and development, substantially reduce premature and low-birth

weight babies as well as infant mortality rates.

The WIC program is funded through the U.S. Department of Agriculture and administered through the Nutrition section of the Nevada State Division of Health. Eligibility is determined through income, health and dietary information. Eligible participants receive

vouchers for purchase of WIC foods that can be used at local grocery stores.

WIC services continue to be available each weekday from 9:00 to 4:00 p.m. at the Operation Life facility at 400 West Jackson Street. Interested persons should call 647-2420 for more information.
