

Government and corporate strategies to preserve struggling minority firms during the downturn are essential.



Dr. Leon H. Sullivan, Founder and Chairman of the National Board of directors of the Opportunities Industrial Centers, will be the guest speaker at the First Business and Industry Dinner at the Imperial Palace on Friday, Oct.

The central theme for the awards program will be "Self-Help for Las Vegas."

In 1964 he founded the OIC, a program sponsoring training and retraining on a massive scale; the first program of its kind in the United States. This program is now operating in more than 125 cities in the United States and is established in Nigeria, Ghana, Ethiopia and Kenya.

Since its beginning OIC has trained more than 300,000 men and women and more than 200,000 have been

placed in gainful employment earning approximately three billion dollars a year in annual income.

In 1963, Rev. Sullivan was cited by Life Magazine as one of the 100 Outstanding Young Adults in the United States.
