OUR GANG 'BUCKWHEAT' DIES AT 49

Straw-hatted and strutting "Buckwheat" of the "Our Gang" comedy series four decades ago, is dead at the age of 49.

The child actor, whose real name was Billy Thomas, was found dead at his Los Angeles home in bed. Police, called by concerned neighbors, climbed through a window of Thomas' house.

He lived alone and, said coroner's investigator Philip Spada, "All we know is there is a son, whereabouts unknown."

Spada said Thomas had been dead two or three days. Death was attributed to natural causes, possibly a heart attack.

"Buckwheat" joined

Spanky, Darla, Alfalfa and the rest of the Our Gang troupe in 1934, at the age of 3. With trademark straw hat and often a "pretend" cigar he strutted through 84 films and his career ended in 1944 when he grew too tall for the role.

The popular series of kid comedies were resurrected on

television as "The Little Rascals" in the 1950s and '60s, much to the delight of another generation of youngsters.

In recent years, Thomas, who became a movie lab technician, was involved in a dispute with a man named James E. Frazier, who claimed that he was the real "Buckwheat."




