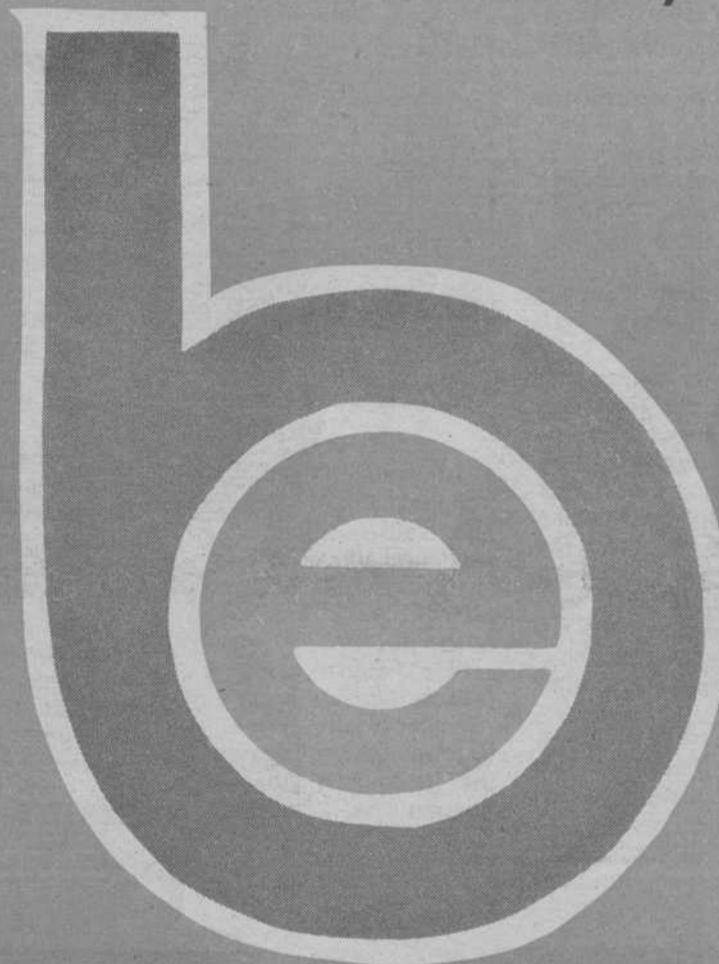

There is much discussion these days among the national black leaders as to their presidential choices. Some are noting the progress blacks have made in federal government during President Carter's term while others are denouncing

the impact his economic program has on black America.

Ebony and Jet magazines along with Coretta King, wife of the late Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. are endorsing the re-election of President Carter. Civil rights leaders Rev.

Ralph Abernathy gave a surprise endorsement to Republican presidential candidate Ronald Reagan.

National Urban League President Vernon Jordan said he will endorse no presidential candidate, but he said the economic policies of

Republican candidate Ronald Reagan "are not likely to win many black votes." He dismissed Independent candidate John Anderson as an ineffective alternative.
