ble ourselves as a child (Mat. 18: 1-4).

Oh, what a responsibility we have as parents, being entrusted with rearing of a child, thereby potentially shaping the development of humanity. So let us arise to the problem and challenge the wisdom concerning one particular past time of our children and endeavoring to remedy the situation...the Popsicle Vendor.

Speaking as a spiritual leader, we are to have concern for the wellbeing of all peoples, both young and old. Jesus told Peter to take care of the little lamb as well as the sheep

(St. John 21:15-16). I have noticed that our children are given to making purchases (right off the street) from the Popsicle vendor, who may be near the school area. I feel the time has come when we, as parents, should cease to allow anyone to peddle to our children, because it is dangerous.

At times, 15-20 children or more may be gathered about the vendor's mobile. Some are running and others are hollering. This tends to create quite an atmosphere of disorder and confusion, all of which increases the threat of unexpectedly being hit by a

passing car. Besides the threat of injury, there also exists the risk of making a purchase from an unverified source. Still to be reckoned with is the economical exchange merited by the nutritional value gained.

Let us raise the consciousness of our children to all factors and likewise instill a proper appreciation for the value of money. Perhaps taking them to the Credit Union and opening a joint savings account may prove to be one useful means of training our children to save their pennies and dimes. Most assuredly on tomorrow

they will be greater men and women for our having done so.
