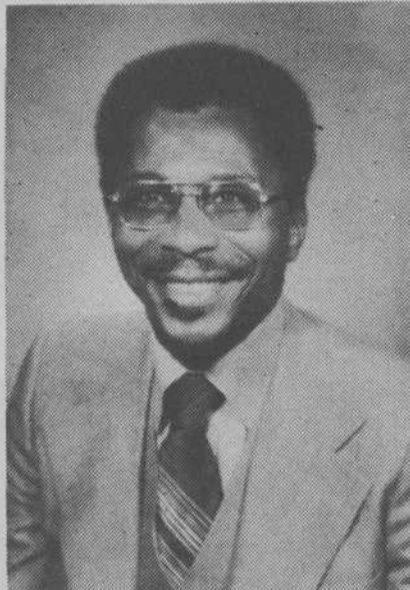

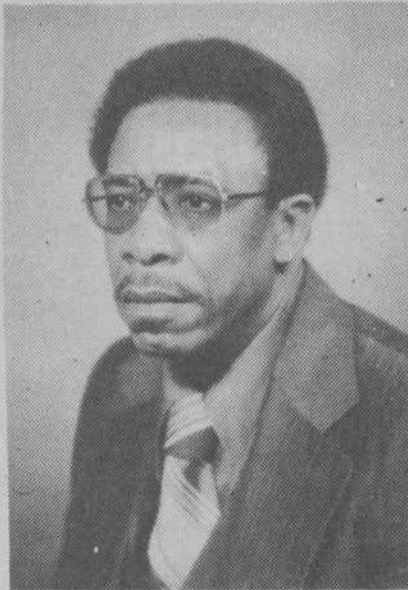

believe that Reagan can cut taxes massively, increase the defense budget drastically, balance the budget, and still leave intact a government that tends to the needs of the least fortunate people in the land.

Reagan's tax-cut plan gives a bonanza to those most able to pay taxes, and virtually nothing to others. His proposals for aiding blacks, Hispanics and other disadvantaged Americans is no different from the "trickle down" schemes of Nixon and Ford — plans that halted the economic progress of minorities.

I cannot gloss over the reality that there is hardly a corporation in America that would ask a 70 year old man to take over its direction next January. So to ask Reagan, at 70, to run this nation seems ludicrous to me.

But even if Reagan were 50, I would conclude that he is not the man I want as president during what could be our most fateful period.
