to move our nation's industrial base forward, it is the responsibility of government to play an important role in balancing interests. It is likewise important that the government be perceived as impartial and not as the ally or tool of big business.

Equally crucial is the need for corporations to be more candid in making public the true state of their finances. So long as these finances are shrouded in corporate secrecy, claims

that business is suffering will be greeted with skepticism by all workers.

The tasks that lie ahead in our country's effort to remodernize industry and to make it more competitive worldwide will require big business to engage in confidence building. Efforts to exclude organized labor and therefore to deny working people their due is an example of untrammelled corporate greed and can hardly stir confidence. Clearly the conduct of Tenneco, Gulf, and Standard Oil of Indiana is hardly in the national interest.
