A Word Of Caution

LEARN GAMING **BEFORE YOU PLAY**

You can legally bet on Dominos in the state of Texas, on Jai-Alai in Nevada and Florida. In Nevada and New Jersey, the only states with casino-type gambling, one of the most popular games is Blackjack or 21 a game now being played all over the world.

The object of the game is to beat the dealer. You try to get a hand that is better than the one the dealer has without exceeding 21. If you draw and get a total of more than 21, you "go busted". You then turn your cards face up and the dealer takes your money.

There are many points to learn that just cannot be explained on paper. It will be to your advantage to learn before you play in the casinos and possibly lose your shirt timing, procedure, etc. Again, if you are a consistent gambler, you need to learn to play in a manner that will prevent your being barred as a Counter, as was mentioned in last week's column.

Blackiack is one of Nevada's greatest sup-

porters in the gaming industry. It is one of the games that the gaming operators depend on for insurance into their sizable yearly net profit.

To most Blackjack players, Blackjack is a guessing game. Every hand that they get is a guess with them. Sometimes they will hit 15 when the dealer has a card large up; sometimes they will stand. Sometimes they will double down on eleven; sometimes they will not. The average player has never read any material about Blackjack and he has no idea how to play the hands correctly. The average player will just not hit 16 when the dealer has a large card up, but if you will notice, he will almost always hit 12, 13 and 14 when the dealer has a small card up. Almost every time that he gets a pair, he will split them without even looking to see what the dealer has for an up card.

So again, I suggest that for your advantage, you learn before you play in the casinos.

I wouldn't want you to be the next guessing person to lose his shirt.
