with the investigation. Private funding sources are holding off on making grants to FSC until the investigation is completed.

Most damaging of all is the suspicion surrounding such an investigation — the feeling that its smoke means there must be fire somewhere. That strikes a blow at an organization's reputation and integrity, eroding its effectiveness.

To date, nothing has been turned up to suggest any irregularities. As the investigation drags on, it appears that its aim is to tie the organization into knots, if not put it out of business altogether.

Justice Department participation in harassing a vital black institution is shameful. The Attorney General ought to step in personally to review the findings and order immediate action — either to take legal action if the evidence indicates it, or to call off the investigators. If the grand jury hasn't found anything in over ten months, there is nothing to find.

And if any investigations are called for, I'd like to see them done by some sharp investigative reporter who might try to find out how the Justice Department and the FBI were dragged in by local politicians, what civil rights laws are being violated in the schools and housing conditions in Sumter County, and, more positively, how the FSC and its member cops are helping to change the lives of the black rural poor.

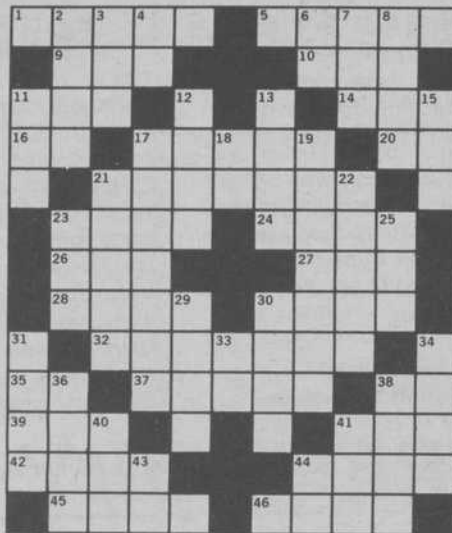
