Boy Scout Troop Sets Judicial Class

Scout Troop 988, is starting a new concept in scouting — a judicial type program, which will entail penalties and fines.

Dorothy Stringfield, troop den leader for Scout Troop 988, reports she has noticed a big difference in the attitude of the members of that troop and other boys who do not belong to it.

Suggested by co-worker Katherine Joseph, the program seeks to teach the

scouts to think before acting and to draw more active support from parents. Stringfield stated further that the troop will "pinpoint anything they consider a misdemeanor type crime and then determine the punishment for the various crimes. Punishment could range from a 50 cent fine to an hour in a blocked off jail." Punishment could also include being suspended from the troop for several meetings or having to

give a 10-minute talk on the subject of the misdemeanor. The program aims to enhance the scouts' sense of direction and sense of honor. They learn right from wrong and to do what is right.

The troop, which was established in 1971, is sponsored by the Economic Opportunity Board of Clark County and meets in the EOB Day Care Center at 1818 Balzar Ave.

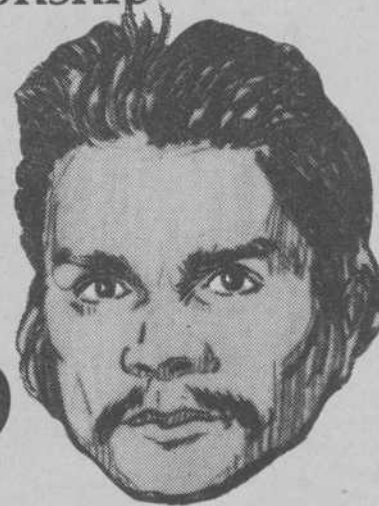
