

NAACP ELECTION DEC. 20

The election date for the local chapter, NAACP has now been reset for Saturday, Dec. 20, according to Dr. James B. McMillan, president of the chapter.

McMillan stated that he would not seek re-election. He will be completing his second two-year term. It is reported that he feels that "the community seems to be dissatisfied with me." He is desirous that the NAACP work be carried on successfully.

The NAACP election was originally scheduled for Dec. 14 but has been reset to give the membership ample time to receive the mailed notices and to be advised of the general

membership meeting which will be held on Sunday, Dec. 7 at the Economic Opportunity Board Day Care Center, 1818 Balzar Ave. at 4 p.m.

The deadline for candidates to file for one of the top five posts up for election will be Sunday, McMillan said.

Candidates desiring to file should present an affidavit signed by three paid-up NAACP members, McMillan reported. Those affidavits will be accepted during the general membership meeting this Sunday.

At the election, members will have the opportunity to vote for the following posts: President, 1st Vice President, 2nd Vice President, Treasurer,

To many the name of James T. Morrison is not significant, but if you use the name DADDI-O in this town it will ring a bell.

DADDI-O is someone special. He is known to many as THE KING OF GAMING. Why? Well, for most of his 91 years he has been involved in gaming — from Chicago, St. Louis, Detroit and Las Vegas, DADDI-O has made his mark.

He was born in Magnolia, Georgia on April 11, 1889 and has outlived his 3 brothers and one sister.

DADDI-O amazes everyone with his alert mind. He is truly young at heart. He talks and walks at a fast clip. Anyone who engages in a conversation on young women will find him holding your attention for days. His philosophy has always been "treat 'em rough, tell 'em nothing and you can get along with 'em."

DADDI-O remembers his early life around Fort

Smith, Ark. He speaks fondly of his parents. His father, Henry, was a railroad worker for most of his life and was known, according to railroad vernacular, as "The Gander Dancer." His mother, Florence, was purely the homemaker who ruled that domain with a firm

hand. How did he wind up in Las Vegas? Well, he fled Chicago with Al Capone on his heels. According to DADDI-O, Capone moved in on his territory while running crap games. "When the deal went down," said DADDI-O "the heat was on

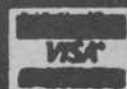
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
