The LAS VEGAS SENTINEL has carefully assessed the plusses and minuses of both candidates for the Secretary-Treasurer post for the Culinary Union, Local 226 and has come to the conclusion that the endorsement of Ben Schmoutey best serves the needs of the Black community.

Despite the fact that this country is in the throes of a recession, the Culinary workers (and they comprise the largest segment of our work force) are better off today than they have been in the past.

It was Schmoutey's quiet, forceful and adept handling of the last contracts negotiations that gave the culinary workers the best contracts ever.
