## 'I Want Sugar Ray,' Says Boxer Thomas (Hit Man) Hearns

t's a variation on an ancient joke. Q: What do you call Thomas Hearns? A: Anything he wants. And in the case of this devastating, 22-year-old welterweight, he prefers to answer to "Thomas" — not "The Cobra" or "The Hit Man," or "The Destroyer from Detroit" characterizations he considers unseemly. "A hit man is a person who goes out to kill people for money," he says. "Sure, I'm getting paid champion: The man general-
