The two most prestigious awards will be for tenure and the most promising new minority business, Key said.

Former presidential candidate Ben Fernandez will be the keynote speaker at the luncheon, Key said. He also was a national surrogate speaker for President Ronald Reagan after the presidential primary.

He said economist Fernandez is an ardent and articulate advocate of the free enterprise system and constantly exhorts audiences to recognize the fact that in America the magic word is "opportunity."

WHEREAS, the State of Nevada is proud to salute these independent business people who operate within the State for the benefit of the citizens of Nevada;

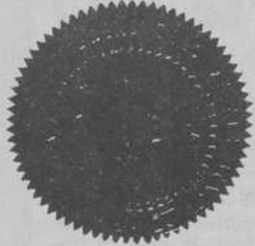
NOW, THEREFORE, I, ROBERT LIST, Governor of the State of Nevada, do hereby proclaim June 5, 1981, in Nevada, as

WHEREAS, the City of Las Vegas is honored to salute these independent business persons who operate within the City for the benefit of the people of Las Vegas;

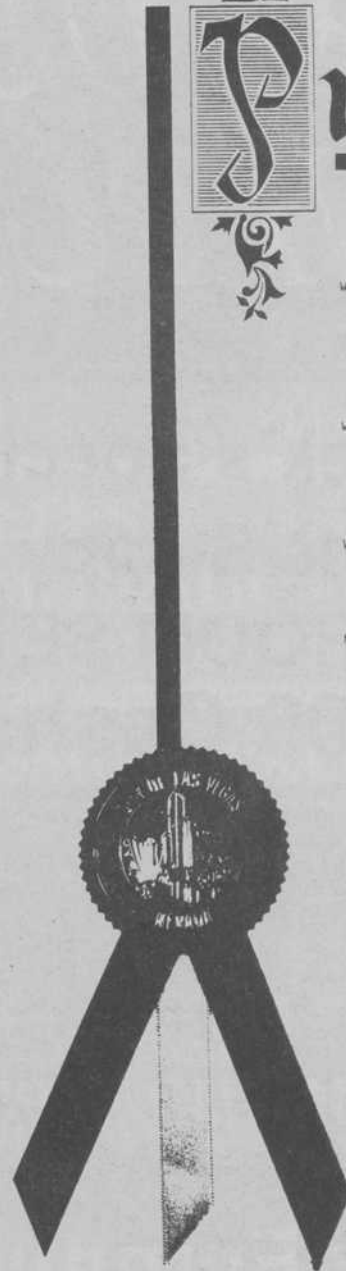
