

HAMSHO-MINTER TOPS ON CAESARS CARD

Mustafa Hamsho, the colorful Syrian-born middleweight from Brooklyn, N.Y., and Alan Minter, the former world middleweight king from Crawley, England, will battle it out over 10 rounds, or less, in the Sports Pavilion at Caesars Palace, Las Vegas on Saturday, June 6th, to earn a shot at the World Middleweight Championship.

Don King Productions is the promoter of the important 160-pound clash that will be televised nationally by ABC-TV but will be blacked out locally.

For Hamsho, 27-years old and looking forward to becoming an American citizen shortly, this culminates a drive that has brought him No. 1 ranking with the World Boxing Council.

Neal Challenged To Boxing Match

"Let the winner decide the fate of Assembly Bill 596," said Charles Anderson, a Reno picket who wears a cross and carries blood-colored dolls.

"Man, that guy is too physical," responded Sen. Joe Neal, D-North Las Vegas, in rejecting Anderson's invitation to fight.

The confrontation developed when Neal canceled a planned Tuesday morning hearing on a controversial abortion bill. The cancellation could cancel AB 596 since the Legislature could adjourn before then.

The bill is a measure which requires doctors to notify the parents when girls under the age of 18 seek abortions. The bill would also force doctors to give husbands a 24-hour advance notice when their wives seek abortions.

The stocky Syrian — he stands 5 feet, 9 inches in height — has lost only one of his fights. He has a record of 30-1-2, with 19 knockouts.

Minter, also 27 years old, holder of the

European Championship, won the World Middleweight title defeating Vito Antuofermo on March 16, 1980, and won by knockout in nine rounds. On September 27, 1980, he was stopped in three rounds by the current undisputed world champion, Marvin Hagler. Minter's record is 39-6-0 with 1 no contest and 23 knockouts.

Also featured will be middleweight bouts between Robby Epps, who recently beat Dwight Davison — the No. 1 contender, vs Ted "TNT" Saunders and

Randy McGrady vs Henry Walker.
