PILOTS-DIVERS

Prospective pilots and scuba divers, here's your chance to get the basic skills and training you've always wanted courtesy of Clark County Community College and their Community Service area.

Private License Aviation, an in-depth course of instruction in aviation operations, will be offered Tuesdays and Thursdays, June 9 through August 13 from 7:30 p.m. until 10 p.m.

The course has emphasis on light aircraft and is designed to prepare students for the FAA Private Pilots written examination. The fee for this course is \$60 and will be taught at North Las Vegas Air Terminal, 2772 N. Rancho Drive.

Advanced Scuba Diving will be taught Tuesdays and Thursdays, June 9 through August 13 at Desert Divers, 5720 E. Charleston. The course will concentrate on different types of underwater techniques such as a deep dive with simulated compression, underwater navigation, underwater photography, a rapid water dive, a beach or boat dive, an optional trip to the California Coast to the Commercial Dive Center, a night dive and a search and recovery dive.

Students are required to complete a minimum of five dives. The fee is \$75 and 3 credits are offered.

If you are a student at Clark County Community College, work full-time, or just can't attend classes at the scheduled time, the Developmental Learning Center at CCCC is right for you.

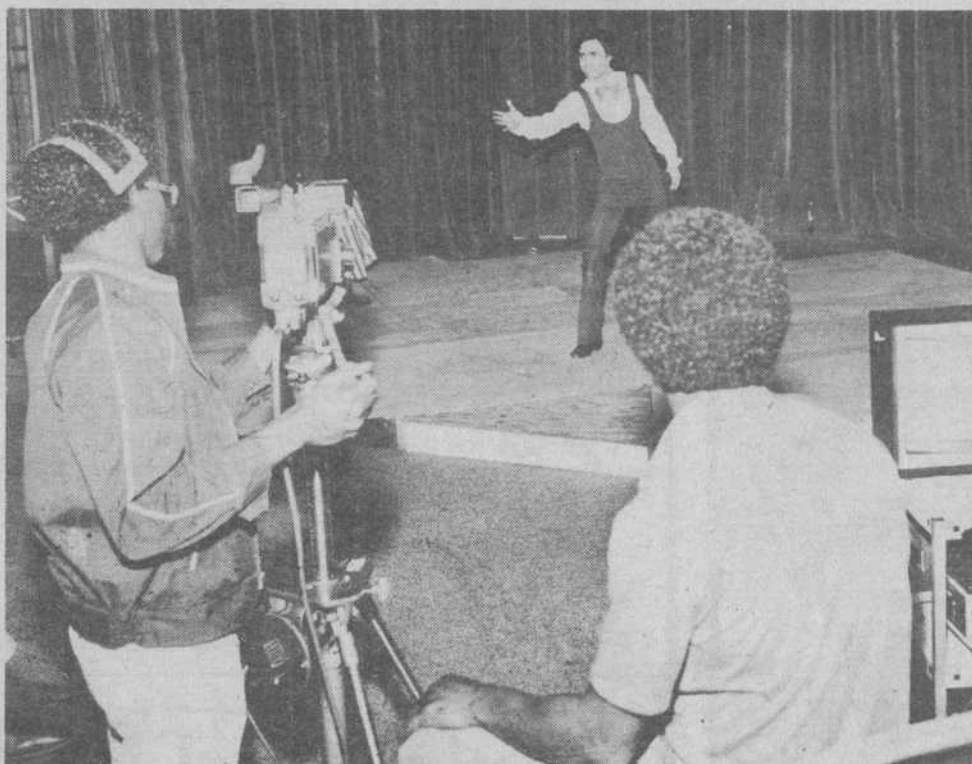
The Developmental Learning at Clark County Community College offers students a chance to study independently through the use of slides, film, tapes and programmed books.
